What You Need to Get Started

Below is a list of the recommended computer specifications for Tajima DG17. Increasing RAM memory and/or processor speed will improve system performance.

- PC with a 3.0 GHz Quad Core Genuine Intel Processor (64-bit)
- Microsoft® Windows® 10/11 (64-bit) operating system
- 16 GB RAM (recommended)
- At least 4 GB hard disk space available.
- Mouse
- A Local Area Network (LAN) Connection
- A Universal Serial Bus (USB) port to attach your security device.

The Tajima DG17 Security Device

The Tajima DG17 software comes with a security device that attaches to the USB port of your computer. The device must be attached for your software to function.

Installing Tajima DG17

To install the Tajima DG17 software, do the following:

- 1. Go to the PulseCloud website to download the latest install file.
- When the download is complete, double click the Install. exe file to open it.
 You see the initial installation window.
- 3. Follow the instructions of each step to complete the installation. For more detailed information on the installation procedure, see the "Installing Tajima DG17" section in Chapter 1 of the User's Guide.

Connecting Hardware

You must connect to two important peripheral devices: the security device and the embroidery machine. For more detailed information, see the "Connecting Hardware" section in Chapter 1 of the User's Guide. Once these devices are connected to the ports at the back of your computer, you can install Tajima DG17.

Connecting Embroidery Machines Through Cable

Tajima DG17 has the capacity to directly connect to embroidery machines through cable. A service called Design Spooler controls the connection to the machines.

For complete details on configuring Design Spooler for your machines, please see the Design Spooler information located in the User's Guide. Connecting machines may require additional hardware or licenses available from your distributor. Please contact your distributor for details.
